2024 DC DataFest FAQs

How do I sign up?

April 12-14-2024

Please fill out the online registration form fully. You can register here: <u>2024 DC</u> <u>DataFest Registration</u>. We only need one application per team. **Registration ends** April 5, 2024.

Is this strictly a statistics activity? Or are the data likely to use other techniques outside of statistics techniques?

This is *not* a statistics activity—it's a data activity! The event is open to anyone with an interest in data, regardless of major.

Who is eligible to compete?

All <u>undergraduate</u> students are eligible.

How large are the teams?

Teams can be made up of two to five students, but we recommend at least three team members if possible.

Do I have to be part of a team to compete?

Yes.

Is the 2024 DC DataFest in person or virtual?

This year's DC DataFest will be virtual! The kickoff and data reveal will be **Friday**, **April 12**, via the Microsoft Teams platform. On **Sunday**, **April 14**, participants will present their findings to our judges virtually. The 2024 DC DataFest winners will be **announced on Sunday**, **April 14**.

What do I need to compete?

All you need is a laptop with tools for data analysis (there is no limitation on what software you use) and enthusiasm for data.
